



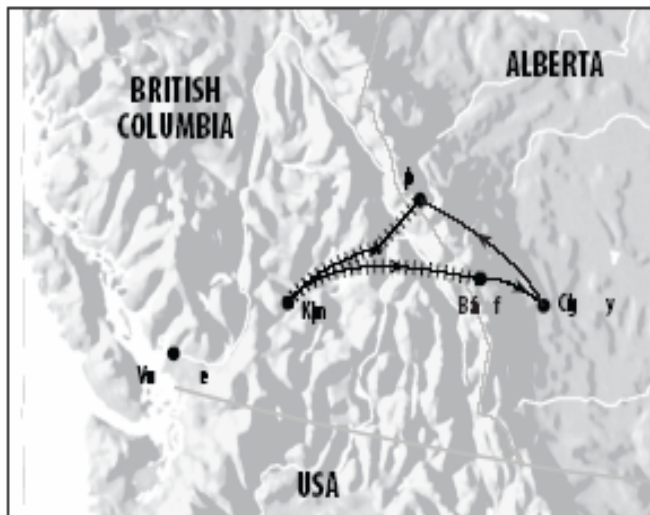

ITINERARY

DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN CALGARY

Arrive at Calgary International Airport and transfer independently to your downtown hotel. Pick up your information kit at the front desk as you check in. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore the many attractions of this urban cowboy city. Overnight in Calgary.

DAY 2 CALGARY TO JASPER

This full-day sightseeing transfer will take you through the sprawling ranching country west of Calgary and along one of the world's most scenic highways – the Icefields Parkway – as you make your way to Jasper.

A stop will be made at the Columbia Icefield where you can choose to take an optional ride on the specially-designed Ice Explorer onto the surface of the Athabasca Glacier. Subsequently, continue along the Athabasca River Valley to Jasper, one of Canada's most-recognised western getaways. Overnight in Jasper.

DAY 3 JASPER

This morning, acquaint yourself further with this idyllic resort town, home to Canada's largest Rocky Mountain Park, wildlife sanctuary and one of North America's largest natural areas. You'll take a guided

tour in Jasper National Park, familiarising yourself with the park's wild inhabitants and railroad history. This will be followed by a visit to the Miette Hot Springs where you will enjoy a rejuvenating soak in the Hot Springs pool. Return to the village and enjoy the rest of the day in this lovely setting. Overnight in Jasper.

DAY 4 ROCKY MOUNTAINEER JASPER TO KAMLOOPS

Board the Rocky Mountaineer train for your rail excursion to Kamloops. This day trip allows you to see some of the grandest sights in western Canada.

Today's route takes you past the Thompson River and ensuingly through the arid ranchland of interior British Columbia and into Kamloops where you will disembark for the night. Upon arrival in Kamloops, you will be transferred to your hotel following which the evening is at your leisure. Overnight in Kamloops.

DAY 5 ROCKY MOUNTAINEER KAMLOOPS TO BANFF

Enjoy a complimentary transfer to the train station for your early morning departure. You will spend another memorable day aboard the Rocky Mountaineer as

it travels eastward towards Banff. Once again, you'll be treated to picture-perfect scenery and relaxing landscapes. Upon disembarking in Banff, the evening is free for exploration. Overnight in Banff.

DAY 6 BANFF

Enjoy another day in this charming all-season resort. On your guided sightseeing tour of Banff you will learn how the 11,000 year old human history of the Bow Valley changed when three railway workers rediscovered the Cave & Basin, now a National Historic Site. There will be stops at many local points of interest. Highlights include: Bow Falls, Banff Springs Hotel, Surprise Corner, Hoodoos & Bow Valley Viewpoint, Lake Minnewanka and the Cave & Basin National Historic Site (admission included). The remainder of the day is free to take a leisurely stroll through the town, browse through local shops and savour fine dining fare. Overnight in Banff.

DAY 7 BANFF TO CALGARY

Today you will be transferred to Calgary leaving behind the enchanting Rockies but taking with you many wonderful memories. The remainder of the day is at leisure to enjoy this Stampede city and its downtown attractions. Overnight in Calgary.

DAY 8 END OF TOUR

Individual transfer to Calgary International Airport to check in for your return flight.
